January 12, 2025: Vice-chancellor of National University (NU) Professor Dr. ASM Amanullah has stressed the need for following updated syllabi and textbooks to help the students face new challenges of the world. Speaking as special guest at a function on "Youth Festival-2025" organised by Bikrampur Kunjabihari Government College in Sirajdikhan Upazila, Munshiganj. Dr. Amanullah regretted that the current syllabus being followed is likely to increase the number of the unemployed every year. There is no point to conduct teaching under obsolete syllabi.
